




Education as a way of life"

Admission Rules & Documents

Admission Rules

Admission Forms for Playgroup to Class IX & XI will be available at School office.

Compulsory Documents to be attached with the admission form:

- Date of birth proof for Nursery to UKG: i.e. Adhaar card or municipality birth certificate or hospital discharge certificate.
- Date of birth proof for Classes I to IX & XI: Adhaar card / TC is mandatory / report card of the Previous school / Birth Ceritificate issued by competent authority. INCOMPLETE FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- The School would inform parents about entrance exam and selection process in due course of time.

Documents

- A photocopy of the birth certificate of their ward's issued by a competent authority at the time of registration.
- Two passport size photographs of the ward and one each of the parents.
- Admission form.
- The Original copy of the Birth Certificate must be produced for verification when required. Children, along with their parents, will be interviewed, by the School Authority.
- Prospectus and application form can be obtained from the school office and completed application forms could be registered by paying a registration fee at the School Counter. The registration fee/admission fees shall be non-refundable.
 - The school reserves the right to test the child in any or all subjects. Admission fees is to be given at time of admission which is non-refundable.
 - Fees has to be deposited on monthly basis or before starting the Quarter.
 - Yearly/Quarter fees will not be entertained at the end of month or year.

Note: The school reserves the right to select or reject any application.

The decision of the school authorities is final as far as granting

/ refusal of admission is concerned.

Transfer Certificate

Students who are under transfer from schools (including outside U.P.) must have their Transfer Certificates counter-signed.

Stream Offered for Class XI:-

Streams Offered - Senior Secondary School

Senior Secondary schooling is essentially a preparation for graduate studies. Students get to select their area of interest as far as subject combinations are concerned. Our school offers students a wide selection of combinations for their Class XII final exams.

This is a two year integrated course and it is in the student's interest to complete both years of study from the same institution.

Note: All students may not get their choice of subjects. Seats in each section are limited and are based on your Class X Board/Final exam results.



1 - The Sciences - Who Should Opt for It?

A student opting for science in Class XI should be a logical thinker, be able to grasp scientific facts and should have an aptitude for it. We have two combinations in the Science stream - Medical and non-medical. The students have to take up five subjects with English being compulsory for all streams.

A - Medical Course

Physics, Chemistry and Biology are compulsory subjects. As a fifth subject, a student may pick up any one of the following: Information Technology, Physical-Education, Vocal Music and Hindi.

B - Non-Medical Course

Physics, Chemistry and Math are compulsory choices. As a fifth subject the student may choose any one of the following: Information Technology, Physical-Education, Vocal Music and Hindi.

We prefer that students who opt for science should have secured 70% or above in their Class X final exams so that they can cope with these subjects.

2 - Commerce

Students opting for the commerce stream have to study a minimum of five subjects. Their compulsory subjects are English Core, Accountancy, Business Studies and Economics. They may opt for any one of the following as their fifth subject- Information Technology, Physical-Education, Hindi and Fine Art.

Students are advised to take up Commerce only if they scored above 65% in their Class X final exam.

3 - Humanities (ARTS)

Students opting for the Humanities (ARTS) stream have to study a minimum of five subjects. Their compulsory subjects are English Core, History, Political Science or Psycology and Economics. They may opt for any one of the following as their fifth subject- Math Information Technology, Physical-Education, Hindi and Fine Art.

Students are advised to take up Humanities only if they scored above 60% in their Class X final exam.

Changing a Course of Study Mid-Way

Students who have taken up a certain course/subject in Class XI and are not satisfied with their choice may apply for a change. The school prefers that you make your decision before the Class XI PA-II/SA-I exams. The change in stream/subjects is allowed only after approval by the board.

General Rules

Our Expectations from Parents and Guardians

Parents must realize that school is a second home for children. They need all the considerations in their favor by way of safety and security, love and co-curricular work. It is from this point of view that we expect parents and guardians to follow the norms, given below, extremely meticulously.

- Parents are expected to go through the school calendar carefully and make a note of important dates and events, especially tests and examinations. During parent teachers meeting, we expect the parents to come in large numbers and meet the concerned teachers to discuss not only the academic progress but also other areas of personality development like attitude, aptitude, confidence building etc.
- 2. Parents must register a permanent mobile phone number/landline number with the school on which SMS and other alerts may be sent. In case of change, the parents MUST notify the changed number in writing within 3 days.
- 3. No student from class IX XII will be allowed to leave the school early on the plea of attending private coaching classes.
- 4. Parents may please see that their child adheres to the school uniform strictly. Children accompanying their parents during PTM days must also come in school uniform.
- 5. Wearing of fancy shoes, jewellery, unruly hair and fancy haircuts like mushroom cut etc., streaking/highlighting of hair by fashion hair colours is not permitted. Skirt hemlines are to be knee-length.
- 6. Parents/Guardians are not permitted to enter class rooms to meet their child/children or to seek unscheduled interviews with teachers during school hours. Prior appointment for meeting the staff must necessarily be taken through green appointment page given at the back of the school Diary.
- 7. In case of emergency, parents/guardians must meet the Principal and adopt a course of action in consultation with them.
- 8. No Strangers Are Allowed To Meet Children and Teachers without permission from School Authority.
- 9. Usage of school bus is compulsory for all students unless, parents take on the responsibility of a drop & pick of their ward.



- 10. The cycle rickshaws with improvised seating for many young children are an illegal and dangerous mode of transportation and are totally banned by the school under instructions from the District Administration.
- 11. Pick up point for private commuters are outside the school. No stranger, driver or family friend is allowed to pick the children up.
- 12. Once the child has come to the school, parents and guardians are not permitted to take him/her back home during the school hours unless there is a major emergency. In such cases, the permission of the Principal / Coordinator is mandatory. Lunch boxes and water bottles are not allowed to be sent for students once they have entered the school premises.
- 13. Parents and guardians must know that no school teacher is allowed to take private tuitions. As such, they should not press the teachers of this school to accept private tuition work for their wards.
- Parents and guardians must immediately inform the school in case there is a change in their address and/or telephone number.
- 15. Any communication that parents wish to make with the school must be addressed to the Principal / Coordinator of the respective wing only and not to the class teachers.
- 16. We expect parents and guardians to be cordial and polite with the staff of the school even in the most taxing situations. Parents are also requested to maintain a proper dress code at all times while entering the school premises.
- 17. Parents are requested to give an advance notice of at least a month for the withdrawal of their wards. Otherwise, a fee equivalent to the tuition fee of one month shall be charged for issuing the transfer certificate.
- 18. Annual Examination (Nursery onwards) are held in March.
- Cumulative assessment of the whole year for the child is considered for promotion into the next class.
- 20. A student who fails twice in the same class will have to be withdrawn from the School.
